

Kickoff is Sunday, February 9, at 5pm. Take advantage of these studies and allow God to do what He desires in your life. Choose from one of the 3 following studies!


GARY THOMAS



Parenting is a school for spiritual formation, says author Gary Thomas, and our children are our teachers. The journey of caring for, rearing, training, and loving our children profoundly alters us forever...even when the journey is sometimes a rough one.

Sacred Parenting is unlike any other parenting book on the market. This is not a "how-to" book that taches readers the ways to discipline their children, Sacred Parenting turns the

tables and demonstrates how God uses children to change their parents. Stepping beyond the overly-tilled soil of method books, parents can learn a whole new side of parenting. They'll be encouraged by stories that tell how other parents handled the challenges and difficulties of being a parent—and how their children transformed their relationship with God. The lesson the author writes about are timeless. But in this edition, Thomas adds in some addition insights and stories that he's learned and lived over the past fifteen years of his own parenting. Gary has found that the lessons have remained much the same, but there are new applications for the readers in this generation who are just now coming this book.
