CONVERSATION

God Created People

GENESIS 2:4-24

When God created the heavens and the earth, at first, there were no shrubs or plants growing because God had not yet made it rain and there was no one to care for the land. So God made a mist of water come out of the ground to water the entire surface of the land. After that, God formed man out of dust from the ground. He breathed the breath of life into him, and the man became a living being.



Then God made a garden in a place called Eden. He put the man there and gave him the garden to work it and watch over it. God made beautiful trees grow that were good for food. In the middle of the garden, He also placed the tree of life and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. The man was allowed to eat from any tree in the garden, but God commanded him not to eat from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil. He warned the man that if he ate from that tree, he would certainly die.

God looked at the man and said, "It is not good for you to be alone."

Then God made every wild animal and every bird in the sky. He brought them all to the man to see what he would call them. Whatever the man called the living creature would be its name. Among the animals the man still did not have a good helper, so God caused a deep sleep to come over the man. While he slept, God took one of the man's ribs and used it to form woman.

When God brought the woman to the man, the man said, "At last! This is bone of my bone and flesh of my flesh. I will call her woman because she was taken from man."

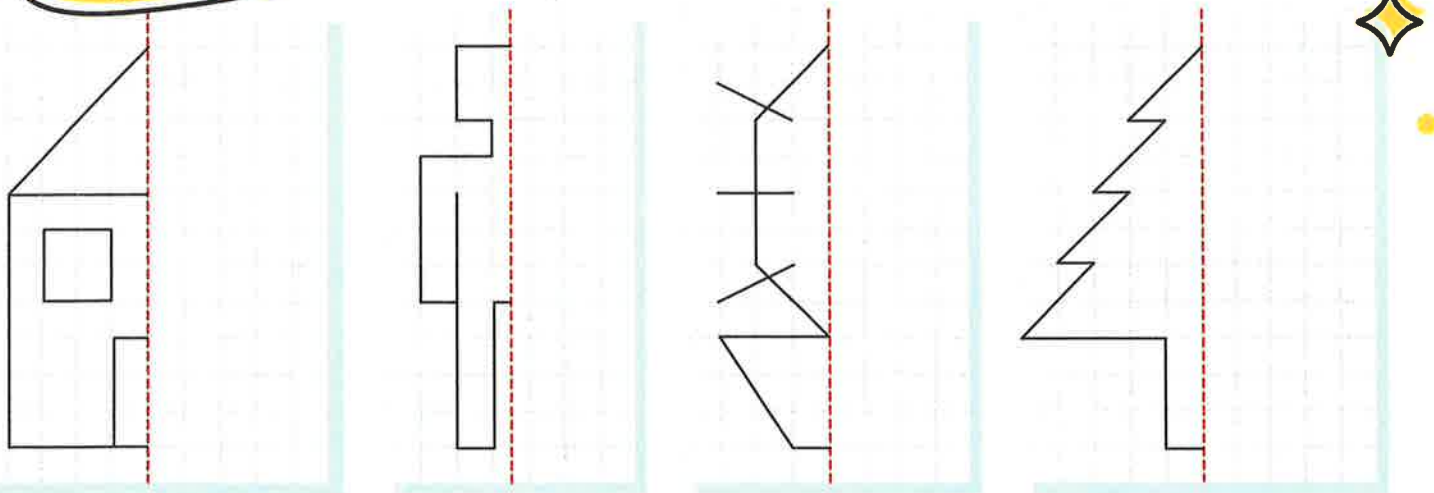
Family Tree
