- A weeknight, such as Tuesday or Thursday, perhaps at 6:00

Please note, "Becoming a Disciple Maker" will NOT be in place of the normal small group study at 5:00 p.m. on Sunday nights. We will also resume small group study in August. What will we be studying?

Dr. David Jeremiah has written a book entitled, "What In The World is Going On? 10 Prophetic Clues You Cannot Afford to Ignore." As I talk to people, I hear a common thought – this world

is changing. It is not only changing, it is changing fast. The changes are not what most would categorize as "good."

The last days of history began with the first coming of Jesus Christ into this world. Since New Testament times, followers of Jesus Christ have been anticipating the second coming of Jesus Christ into this world. Jesus did not come back during their days on earth! So, what makes us think we might just be that generation? Every generation is to live knowing the return of Jesus Christ is imminent. Right now God's people are asking some great questions. Are we in the last of the last days? Will there really one day be a one world government? Will the Man of Lawlessness also called the Antichrist really rule the earth. Will all those terrible things told in the book of Revelation really one day happen? In this study we will look to Scripture for God's wisdom in these matters and hopefully answer some questions you might have.
