Christmas greetings Church Family,

During the next week, if you have not done so already, please complete the “Bylaws Review Form” and mail or bring it to the church office. Every member of this local body of believers is important. Every member’s view is equally important. In the next few days spend some time thinking through the Bylaws and asking God for His leading. May we together cry out to our Father, “Almighty God, how do you want us to function as the local body of believers known as FBC Yazoo City?”

Mark your calendars for Wednesday, December 13, 2023 at 6:00 p.m. The church body, in a business session on November 26, 2023, engaged in healthy discussion regarding the proposed budget for 2024. The decision was made to extend the discussion of the budget to December 13<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 p.m. Please make plans to be present for this discussion. Please understand that the purpose of this meeting is for discussion. No vote on the proposed budget will be taken at this time. A vote on the proposed budget, with no discussion, will take place following the worship service on December 17, 2023.

During this Christmas season let’s be reminded of the true reason we celebrate! It is a terrible and sobering reality – everyone ever born into this world is a sinner against God. I am. You are. They are. All are. “ALL have sinned and fallen short [missed the mark] of the glory of God (Romans 3:23).” The news gets worse, “For the wages of sin is death (Romans 6:23).”

God makes it abundantly clear that He is holy. In His being, in Who He eternally is, God IS absolutely without sin, wickedness, evil, immorality, or anything else that could be called wrong. When God created Adam and then Eve, they were created holy, without sin. God gave Adam and Eve the ableness to make choices – even to choose to disobey. Disobey they did. Adam and Eve chose to sin. The choice to sin plummeted the entire human race into sin and eternal spiritual death. Through Paul, God tells the Christians in Corinth, “For as in Adam all die (spiritually and physically) ... (1 Corinthians 15:22, Genesis 3:19).”

As long as sinful mankind remained sinful, sinful mankind could never be in relationship with Holy God! Nothing on earth existed that could make sinful mankind to again be without sin. No animal sacrifice was sufficient (Hebrews 9:13). No human sacrifice was sufficient – because all have sinned. Sin cannot make payment for sin.

What is needed? A perfect sacrifice, a sacrifice that is absolutely holy. Holy can make payment for sin. But who, what human being could be such a holy sacrifice?

No such person existed on earth. God was fully aware of that fact.

God for eternity had an amazing plan to make payment for the sins of mankind. Holy God would become a man Himself and make payment for the sins of mankind (Revelation 13:8). God reveals to us in His word that this God-man, Who would/and did make the payment for the sins of mankind, is Who we know and understand is Jesus Christ.

- John 1:1-2 – “In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was in the beginning with God.”
- John 1:14 – “The Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we have seen His glory, glory as of the only Son from the Father, full of grace and truth.”
- John 1:29 – “The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him and said, “Here is the Lamb of God, Who takes away the sin of the world!”
- John 3:16 – Jesus said, “For God loved the world in this way: He gave His One and Only Son, so that everyone who believes in Him will not perish but have eternal life.”
- Romans 5:8 – “But God proves His own love for us in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us!”
- Romans 6:9 – “We know that Christ, being raised from the dead, will never die again; death no longer has dominion over Him.”
- Romans 10:9 – “... if you confess with your mouth that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.”
- Romans 6:23 – “the free GIFT of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord.”

At Christmas we celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ, God becoming man, Immanuel - God with us! At Easter we celebrate the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ our LORD! Jesus Christ truly is God’s perfect GIFT to mankind! “Thanks be to God for His indescribable (inexpressible) GIFT (2 Corinthians 9:15).”

There is no greater GIFT a human being can ever receive than the GIFT of salvation in Jesus Christ! I hope and pray that you have received this GIFT of salvation, of forgiveness of your sins, by God’s grace through faith in Jesus Christ!

This December ask God to lead you to someone who needs God’s GIFT. In grace and love open your heart to this person. Tell him or her about Jesus Christ, thus giving this person the opportunity to receive the greatest GIFT ever given – eternal salvation of his/her soul, the GIFT from GOD that keeps on giving forever and ever!
