My fellow laborers in Jesus Christ,

Happy New Year! It is hard to believe it is already 2024! I pray this year we as God's people embrace every second for God's glory in every facet of our lives! I would like to begin this year by asking ...

Do you know of anyone who used to be involved in the local church but no longer is? Do you know of anyone who used to seek God but doesn't have much to do with God anymore? For too many of us the answers are "yes" and "yes." Why does that happen? There are a number of reasons these things happen. Those who gather statistics tell us that topping the list is a lack of discipleship in the local church. Let's define what discipleship is. It is so much more than being a part of another small group study.

In the days when Jesus walked the earth a disciple would sit at the feet of his master and learn from him - soaking in the knowledge and character and wisdom of the master seeking to become as he is. You and I are called to be disciples of Jesus Christ.

"Then Jesus said, "Come to me, all of you who are weary and carry heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you. Let me *teach* you, because I am humble and gentle at heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy to bear, and the burden I give you is light (Matthew 11:28-30)."

As we sit at Jesus' feet, seek and obey Him, His indwelling Holy Spirit transforms us to be like Him. Being a disciple of Jesus is to be a way of life. With every breath a disciple seeks to know, love, obey Jesus Christ and lead others to do the same.

On December 17, 2023 we heard from five fellow laborers in the LORD – how God had moved in each of their hearts through a disciple making opportunity entitled, "Becoming a Disciple Maker." This twelve-week study focused on 3 things:

- Making sure the participant is sitting at the feet of Jesus and learning from Him
- Learning how to share the Gospel message with others
- Becoming equipped to help new believers learn to sit at the feet of
 Jesus, grow in Him through the reading and study of God's word,
 hiding the word of God in their hearts, teaching them how to pray,
 etc. in order that they may lead someone else to do the same.

We often think of making disciples as leading people to trust in Jesus – which definitely is a part of it. Too often we direct a new believer to attend church, join a Sunday School class, read a devotional, and perhaps even be a part of a new believer or new member class. Those are worthy goals.

Stats tell us that many of these people find their way to the back door of the church never to be seen again. Why? They were never taught how to be a disciple and make disciples of Jesus Christ. Consider the following illustration.

Charlie leads one person a week to Jesus. Sam leads one person a day to Jesus! Charlie and Sam *do not teach* the new believers how to be disciples and make disciples. Floyd has a different approach. Floyd leads one person a year to Jesus AND then *invests his life* into the new believer so that he/she would be an authentic disciple and disciple maker of Jesus Christ.


You can see the difference that making disciples has over the years. Charlie and Sam have led many to Jesus. After 33 years, according to real life stats, more than some of those 1,716 people Charlie led to Jesus and the 12,045 people that Sam led to Jesus are likely no longer in church or perhaps even seeking God at all. On the other hand, it is highly likely that the 8,589,934,592 people who have been taught to be true disciples of Jesus are still walking deeply with Jesus and are still leading others to do the same!

Another discipleship opportunity of "Becoming a Disciple Maker" will likely begin in latter January. Please consider being a part of what God is seeking to do in and through our lives as the people of FBC!


