For many years, I, you, and perhaps millions of other believers have cried out to God to overturn the 1973 Supreme Court decision known as Roe v. Wade. On this past Friday, the Supreme Court in a 5-4 decision chose to reverse the Roe v. Wade decision which in effect had made "the right to abortion" the law of the land. No longer could states decide this issue for themselves as had been the case prior. Without going into the specifics, I fully support the decision of the Supreme Court. Rightly, and constitutionally, this issue is now back in the hands of the citizens of each state.

I praise God for answering so many prayers and undoing a terrible decision that opened a door which led to the killing of over 60 million innocent persons in the wombs of their mother! Prayer matters! God is listening! Remember, how you live your life, and what you then pray is taken by God and used in accordance with His will and righteousness. As God tells us through James, "The prayer of a righteous person has Mr. Kennedy went to the 50-yard line after each football great power as it is working."

When God's people yield to, obey, and stand for God's truth and pray THEN God as He chooses does what only He can do! I believe God has moved in tis decision and He has done so because God's people have prayed. Let's celebrate this decision and continue to yield to, obey, and stand for God's truth. May we ALWAYS do so in LOVE AND GRACE! The overturning of Roe v. Wade did not declare abortion illegal. Abortion is still legal. Abortion is still a very celebrated option by many across this nation. Just turn on your TV and you will hear many who think very differently from those who uphold a biblical worldview of life and when it begins. I just read a memo from the Mississippi Baptist Convention to be aware that churches may find themselves targeted by those who enraged over the decision of the Supreme Court. Teenage girls and adult women with unwanted pregnancy still have a choice to make—to abort or not. With the landmark decision by the Supreme Court teenage girls and adult women with unwanted pregnancies will now have another choice to make. Will she seek a state who will allow abortion [praise the LORD Mississippi will not!] or will she seek help from those who want her to bring another precious child out of the womb and into this world?

This is where you and I as God's children can make a great

difference. Pray that pregnant women hear and see from Christians, the Church, and from Pregnancy Centers the love of God, the grace of God, and tangible help in deciding to choose to give that child an opportunity to live outside the womb. And may we individually and as church body find ways to support Crisis pregnancy centers who provide sound biblical counsel, ultrasounds, and minister to pregnant women in other amazing ways. For example, you might consider supporting such organizations as preborn.org. or the Center for Pregnancy Choices [cpcmetrofriends.org] in Jackson, MS.

As I was writing this article, the Supreme Court handed down another important decision. SCOTUS awarded victory to Mr. Joseph Kennedy, Mr. Kennedy is a high school football coach in Bremerton, Washington. What did Mr. Kennedy do to eventually become the subject of the highest court in the land?

The school board instructed Kennedy to stop praying because it interfered with his duties as a public school official, was being done on public property, it involved students [who were never asked to come and pray but chose to pray], and it even perhaps made some students feel life they too HAD to pray with him on the field. After years in the courts and many believers praying and seeking God's intervention, the Supreme Court ruled in favor of Mr. Kennedy and his first amendment right to exercise his religion, to pray. This is a victory for the constitution, the first amendment, and religious liberty!

We see a lot going wrong in our nation. Be encouraged my brothers and sisters. These are two examples of things going right. When we stand with God and on God's Word, we stand with Him. Open your eyes and heart to the world, nation, state, and city in which you live—there is a lot to pray about! We have been reminded—prayer matters! What are you waiting for? Let's pray...
