

Beloved Church Family,

One of the roles of the Finance Team is to encourage God's people to be faithful stewards of the resources that God entrusts to them. A steward is someone who manages the property or resources that belong to someone else. As God's children in Jesus Christ we understand that all we have is from His hand. It is true that each of us works very hard in order to have a place to live, food to eat, money to pay the bills, and so forth. Even the ability to do whatever you do is a gift to you from God! God reminded Israel and He reminds His Church, "When you have eaten your fill, be sure to praise the LORD your God for the good land He has given you. But that is the time to be careful! Beware that in your plenty you do not forget the LORD God and disobey His commands, regulations, and decrees that I am giving you today ... remember the LORD your God, for it is He who is giving you power to make wealth (Deuteronomy 8:10-12, 18)."

God is a giving God. God calls His children to be giving children. God calls us to the discipline of giving. That is giving a portion of what He gives us - back to Him - to the local church in which we are invested, and giving to wherever else His Spirit leads.

Through Paul, God instructs followers of Jesus Christ, "Remember this-- a farmer who plants only a few seeds will get a small crop. But the one who plants generously will get a generous crop. You must each decide in your heart how much to give. And don't give reluctantly or in response to pressure. 'For God loves a person who gives cheerfully.' And God will generously provide all you need. Then you will always have everything you need and plenty left over to share with others (2 Corinthians 9:6-8.)"

God calls us to give as an act of trust – in HIM! God calls us to give with joy in our hearts and praise on our lips because we get to participate with Him in what He will do through these gifts to impact the world for His glory! Because we have trusted and obeyed – we are going to get to experience even more of God at work in our lives! It is amazing what happens when God's child gives. The more you give the deeper your trust in your Father grows!
